Utility Junior Group:

Best: M.Aquilina's Miniature Poodle, Curly Brown-M Della Baia Blu, Lovely moving male who was so well constructed with a lovely head and expression. Good size and proportions with firm topline. Shown in excellent coat and condition.

Reserve: E.Meli's Toy Poodle, Island Of Lotuses Centurion, Head of good shape and well-shaped eyes full of expression. Good neck and shoulders. Firm topline and tail carriage. Elegant and free Easy movement.

Utility Puppy Group:

Compact and well ribbed with high set and well carried tail. Shown in excellent coat and condition. Great rapport with his handler. A pleasure to award him Best Puppy in Show.

Reserve Best Puppy In Show: Golden Retriever: Shiva's Golden Agnese, What an exciting young Golden Retriever bitch with a lovely head and kind expression. Totally balanced angulation and of correct size and proportions for age.

Best Junior In Show: W.Chetcuti's Whippet, Frontrunner's The Look, Smart young bitch with a super outline. Feminine and elegant but still with strength. Excellent topline and underline, strong hindquarters with balanced angulation. An excellent sound mover.

Best In Show: Labrador Retriever: Sh.Ch. Neville Open Heart, absolutely stunning mature Labrador with a lovely outline. Beautifully balanced throughout with good length of leg. Good breadth of skull, strong clean neck and strong, well ribbed body. Excellent topline, tailset, good bone and feet. Sound and free moving. Shown in excellent coat and condition. A pleasure to also award this fabulous dog Best in Show.

Reserve Best In Show: M.Albanese's Alaskan Malamute, Int.It.Hr.Alb.Mne.Rks.Bih.Si.Ch.Astrid Doroteya, Quality bitch with excellent bone yet still feminine. Strong moderate neck into firm topline, week developed ribs and well-muscled hindquarters. Excellent angulation and good tail set and carriage. Shown in excellent coat and condition.
