LATE SHOW ENTRY FEES per Show (2nd Closing date of entry): **An additional €3.00 per entry to the above rates will be applied.**

All dogs being shown must be fully registered with the MNCF – Dogs cannot be shown TBR (To be Registered) anymore. Therefore, the ORIGINAL Export pedigree must be produced at our office for registration purposes, copies will not be accepted. For those who have not received their export pedigrees and still want to show their dogs, this can only be done as a foreign entry on the breeder's name. A copy or image of the normal pedigree will be needed for this. All dogs who were previously shown as TBR and not yet produced their original Export Pedigree will not have their entries accepted until such original Export Pedigrees are produced and can only be shown as foreign entries.

All Owners and Handlers of dogs being exhibited must be 2024 paid up members with the Malta Canine Society. Any exhibits found to have been handled by non-paid up members will be disqualified

Membership Fees: Single Membership: €25.00; Family Membership: €35.00; Juniors: €15.00.

Ribbons will be awarded to the winners of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Best Of Breed. Prize Cards for Best Bitch, Best Dog, Best Junior in Breed and Best Puppy In Breed. Special Rosettes will be awarded to the Group winners, Reserves etc. Special Trophies will also be awarded to the Best In Show, Reserve B.I.S, Best Puppy In Show, Reserve Best Puppy In Show, Best Junior In Show & Reserve Best Junior In Show. Certificates will only be issued upon order. Additional Prizes for Group Winners and BIS are being awarded by Eukanuba at their discretion.

- Entry passes: Only Exhibitors are given free entry passes. Members not exhibiting on the day must pay to enter the venue.
- Exhibitors must make sure to pick up after their dogs. Those caught not adhering to this will be disqualified from the show on the spot. This also applies to any dog hair or other rubbish being left lying around at the venue.
- Exhibitors are urged to arrive early at the venue
- Dogs arriving late or missing their classes will not be admitted in the ring even if they are the sole exhibit in their class or breed.
- Restaurant/Bar facility available at the venue.
- Set up of Gazebos to be done on Friday 24th May between 7:30pm-9:00pm or on Saturday 25th May between 9.00am – 10.00am. **Exhibitors are to place their cages/tables on either a piece of carpet or plastic to avoid damaging the artificial turf. Such underlay should be provided by the exhibitor him/herself.**

This Venue is used daily by children – Act Responsibly – Keep the venue and surrounding grounds clean – Anyone being caught not picking up after their dogs will be disqualified from the show on the spot and further disciplinary actions will be taken.

Smoking is not permitted on the turfed areas. Those smoking in permitted areas should dispose of their cigarette butts in the provided tins.

MEET THE JUDGES:



Tom H Johnston MPhil (Edin), MPhil (CNNA), FIBMS. - 'FELDKIRK'

Born in Edinburgh but now residing in the South of Scotland, worked for the National Health Service and University Departments as a Scientist in Bacteriology and Virology and in later years as a Cytogeneticist. Been an active member and officer on several Championship Shows and a member of the Royal Kennel Club.

Started off my show career with Dobermans in the mid 70's, this was closely followed by Border Terriers and Basenjis, in recent years campaigning Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Hungarian Vizslas and Flatcoated Retrievers to their UK titles. I have owned and bred Champions in Rhodesian Ridgebacks Hungarian Vizslas and Flatcoated Retrievers, the latter breeding Top Dogs and the Bitch CC Record Holder-

Sh.Ch.Feldkirk Fashion being Top Flat Coat for 5 years. Also bred Sh.Ch. Feldkirk Dior Of Kazval who was Top Flatcoat puppy, Top Gundog Puppy, overall runner up Pup of the Year, gained her title as a yearling and went on to be Top Flatcoated Retriever in 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023, winning Gundog Groups and several Group placings.

I first started judging in 1983 and awarded CC's for the first time in 1993, Basenjis. I am Kennel Club approved to award CC's in 90 breeds over 7 Groups and also approved to judge the Terrier, Hound, Gundog, Utility, Working and Pastoral Groups & Best in Show. I have judged in many European Countries as well as Dubai, South Africa, Hong Kong, Australia and New Zealand.

I am an active member of the The Scottish Breed Canine Club, Caledonian Canine Society, Chairman of the Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of Scotland, Secretary of The Hound Association of Scotland. Member of the Kennel Club and fortunate to be a current Group Steward at Crufts. I am privileged have judged on several occasions at Crufts and judged the Terrier Group Crufts 2020. I have judged in many European Countries as well as Dubai, South Africa, Hong Kong, Australia and New Zealand.



Mr Frank H Whyte - KAZVAL

I was brought up with racing Greyhounds and Whippets and on leaving home my first dog was a Labrador, followed by a Cocker Spaniel which introduced me the show scene. In 1980 I bought my first Welsh Springer Spaniel who became my first champion, and the foundation bitch of my Kazval Welsh Springer's, closely followed a blue Cocker Spaniel and Flat coated Retriever who both became Champions. In the early



90's I got my first Hungarian Vizsla. I have been Top Breeder in Welsh Springer's and Hungarian Vizsla's as well as having had Top Dogs in these breeds. I still currently show Flatcoats and Vizslas but enjoy being around many breeds. I have achieved Top Dog in Flatcoat Retrievers on several occasions.

I award CC's in the UK to 32 Gundog Breeds and CC's in the Hound and Utility Groups. I am also approved to judge the Gundog Group, Hound Group and Best In Show at Championship Show level.

I have judged in many countries throughout Europe as well as Dubai, Pakistan, Australia, New Zealand, and South Africa. I have bred, owned, or handled 30 UK Champions covering 6 breeds from 3 groups.

I am an active Committee Member of the Scottish Kennel Club (2002 till present day). Apart from Championship Shows I've judged extensively many Open Shows, in which I've judged various breed classes over all groups and many Variety Classes (All Breeds) Groups and Best In Shows, over 800 classes judged.

I have owned, bred and handled dogs to their Champion title in many breeds, 13 Welsh Springer Spaniels – 13 UK Show Champions, 1 Scandinavian, 1 Dutch, 1 New Zealand and 1 South African Champion. 3 Top brood Bitches, 1 Top Stud dog and Top Breeder award. Hungarian Vizsla – 7 UK Show Champions – 1 Breed Record Holder, Top Dog and Top Breeder award. Cocker Spaniel - 1 UK Show Champion. Flatcoated Retriever – 8 UK Show Champions, Top Puppy, Several Top Flatcoats, Group Winners & Group Placers. Rhodesian Ridgeback - 1 UK Champion, Group Winner & Placings and Res BIS UK Ch Show Tibetan Terrier - 1 UK Champion and Group Placer.
